RE-valorization – re-discovery of various mass-housing concepts with strong social foundation and a deep study, finding still unknown values and achievements of different architecture and planning approaches.

RE-vitalization – re-using and re-thinking 20th century mass-housing experience and relevance to modern living standards and possibilities of re-configuration to new functions.

RE-storation – reconstruction and restoration concerns including modern architecture specifics i.e. reinforced concrete and experimental materials, prefabricated parts etc.

This course gives a wide overview of the architectural solution of the residential development in Moscow of the 20th century. Following an introduction to the history of architecture and urban development in Moscow during the century of experiments will be surveyed with special reference to the works of Russian Avant-garde.

The course is suitable for students of any specialization, especially Architecture and Urban Studies, and related subjects such as History, Design, Urban Sociology and Anthropology or Fine Arts. Basic sketching and graphical tools (hand or computer) skills are required.

Students from Germany are eligible to apply for **DAAD go east!** scholarship.

Russian language course

Students can start intensive Russian course without any prior knowledge of language or can improve their Russian proficiency.

The course aims to improve listening, reading, writing and speaking skills, practice and expand students' vocabulary and knowledge of grammar and phonetics

- Russian speaking and listening.
- Russian Communication Skills.
- Russian for Academic Purposes.

Language course is integrated into the programm, allowing students to combine professional knowledge with cultural and language skills.

Accommodation

Participants of the summer school will be accommodated on university campus in our dormitories with access to kitchen, laundromat and internet.

Our highly developed university campus with total area of 120 hectares is located inside Moscow city right next to "Losiniy Ostrov" National Park. Commute from campus to the city center takes 30 minutes via public transportation.

Deadline for application is June 1st.

Upon successful completion of summer course students will be awarded with 3 ECTS credits and 1 additional ECTS credit for completion of Russian language course.
